

In-Person Service FAQ

How Can I Reserve a Spot For Our In-person Services at Oak Hills Church?

We offer a 9:30a service with Family Life Ministry for ages 0 yrs - 5th grade and an 11:00a All-Family Service. We encourage you to reserve seats for yourself and any others who will attend by going online to our events page. You can make your reservation right up until the service you wish to attend - this reservation guarantees your space in our service, helps us to know how many people to expect, and keeps safe social-distancing throughout the building. Please sign up with those whom you feel comfortable sitting and be respectful to other parties.

What Happens Once I Arrive?

- Go to the North Door with your reservation. Seating will begin 15 minutes before the service begins.
- Masks are required in the building and throughout the service. One will be provided if needed.
- Please observe 6 foot social distancing at all times.
- Our staff and volunteers will guide you through a contactless experience.

How Will I Participate in Worship?

We are adhering to all Minnesota State guidelines for a house of worship.

- Masks are required for anyone 5 years or older and strongly encouraged for those ages 2-5 years.
- Maintain 6 foot distancing throughout the building.
- Those on stage will not be wearing masks, but will be at least 12 feet away from the congregation.
- Programs will not be distributed. Please check our website for the most up-to-date information.
- You are welcome to **socialize** with others **outdoors** after the service. In order to ensure the safety and comfort of all who are attending, please do not congregate indoors.

Is Family Life Programming Available?

Family Life Programming is now available at our 9:30a In-Person Service for ages 0 yrs to 5th grade. Reservations are encouraged and appreciated to ensure there is sufficient space available, and can be found on the In-Person Sunday Services events online. What Safety Precautions Is Oak Hills Church Taking?

- We are deep cleaning after each event with high-contact surfaces being sanitized more frequently.
- Staff and volunteers are wearing masks. Hand sanitizer stations are placed throughout the building.
- No coffee or water is being served at our services.
- The auditorium's air ventilation is always running; per recommendations, we have increased the outdoor air flow coming into the building and scheduled the air ventilation system to run in all spaces where people are scheduled to be.
